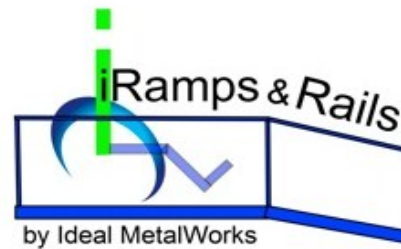


## Comparison of Wood vs Steel Ramps with Railings

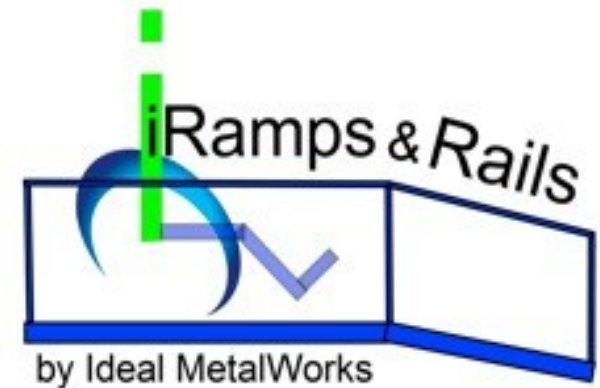

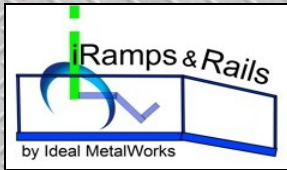

## ADA Requirements for Public Spaces

(ADA compliance for personal residences is usually optional—guideline only)

Slope	1:12
Handrails	Required if more than 6" rise (*)
Side Flanges	2" required (*)
Platform (Landing)	Anything exceeding 30 feet (*)
Rails	12" beyond end of Ramp (*)
Non Skid Surface	Required (*)
Water Accumulation	None (*)

(\*) These items are designed into iRamps & Rails products

An ADA-compliant handicap ramp will run approximately \$100 per foot installed. Add approximately \$800 for platform if needed.

Rentals are approximately 10% of purchase cost per month, plus installation charge of \$100.00.

If the need exceeds six months and you wish to purchase, we will credit 75% of the rental against the purchase price.
